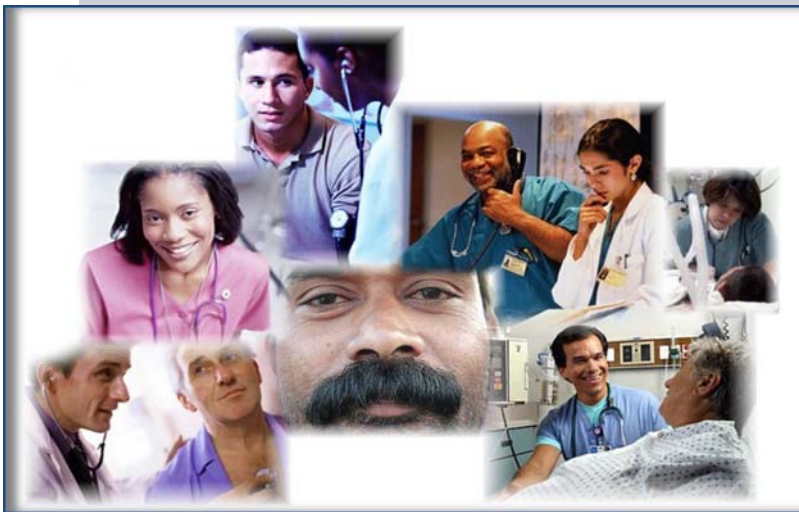


The Camino de Salud Network “Access to the Right Care, at the Right Place, at the Right Time”

Network Goal:

“To develop a sustainable healthcare system with neighborhood access to primary care; enhanced access to specialty and diagnostic care; and the coordination of primary care with inpatient and outpatient specialty and diagnostic services”

Network Components

Patient Flow & Systems Redesign—Assignment of every patient within the LAC+USC Medical Center to a Medical Home local to their community in addition to direct admission procedures and appropriate patient disposition will reduce avoidable use of hospital services.

Specialty Care Redesign— Through the creation of consensus care guidelines and implementation of an educational component in the form of mini-fellowships, Network partner providers are able to expand their scope of practice and manage patients in need of specialty care at their site.

Care Management— The Care Management component identifies the most frequent users of health services within the Network’s patient population and provides them with intensive care management.

Health Information Exchange— Network partners are currently provided with access to their patients’ medical records on Affinity

Financial Sustainability— Financial Sustainability is achieved by improving efficiencies and leveraging existing resources within Network partners, as well as by redirecting primary care services to partnering community clinics.

Performance Management—Implementation of measurement and evaluation methods increases adherence to Network guidelines, allowing for effective management of the Network.
